


## Half the precipitation of normal






#### Less than 20 inches








#### 2020 WY was bad; 2021 is worse





## Don Pedro likely to finish 2021 around 700' elevation














#### Challenges of statewide comparison







- March 18 to October 27
- Dry Year Rate Schedule
- Available water for each irrigated parcel is 34 inches per acre
- Due to the below average water year, wait times to receive water may be longer than normal







- Available Water reductions in 2020 (42") and 2021 (34")
- Turlock Lake operated to reduce evaporation and seepage
- Lateral 8 Regulating Reservoir
- Operational spills goal of less than 5 percent
- Ceres Regulating Reservoir in the works
- Drought workshop held December 2020
- Relaxed water transfer program this year
- Always looking for additional conservation measures
- Enhanced Online Water Ordering System



# Online Water Ordering System (waterrequest.tid.org)

- Desktop and mobile
- View real-time usage data
  - Group your parcels
  - See Delivered AF and Remaining AF
  - Total usage percentage bar
  - Parcel Summary page
  - Export to your own spreadsheets or pdfs
- Order water easily
  - From the field
  - After hours
- Forecast your season
  - Input: configuration, hours, date
  - Computes: AF, hours, inches or irrigations

Local agencies to form GSAs by 6/30/17 or state may intervene





#### **Get results**

No "undesirable results", meet goals, or state may intervene
