The Department of Pesticide Regulation is moving forward with the development of a statewide pesticide application notification system. Stanislaus County has decided to participate in a pilot project in the Grayson area and has already met to discuss the initial design of the program and is in the process of gathering input from the growers and community members. The pilot project is expected to launch in April.
