We want to take a moment to review information surrounding apiary registration developments for 2024. There has been a lot of change, and everything is not settled yet. If you have any questions, please direct them to our office:

- 1. The <u>Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, 45-Day Notice</u> was completed and the <u>apiary registration regulations</u> changes are going through the process of being adopted. The comment period closed on Nov. 11, 2023.

- 2. The proposed fees as listed on the new regulations are:

Number of colonies	Fee
1-9 colonies	\$0
10-50 colonies	\$100
51+ colonies	\$250

- 3. The payment portal is currently being developed. We have the following options for making payments for Apiary Registration:
 - a. Wait to remit electronic payment, once payment portal is established, we will reach out to each apiary with the link to pay the registration fee.
 - b. You may write a check, made out to *CDFA*, *Apiary Registration*.
 - i. The checks will be collected by our office and sent to CDFA.
- 4. You can register your hives with the attached form or online via https://beewhere.calagpermits.org/
 - a. The fees are to be paid within 30 days of possession of the apiary.
 - i. We will offer a grace period between now and the time the online payment portal is available. Once the portal is available, we will email all registered beekeepers to supply the link and instructions to pay. It is imperative that we have your email address to facilitate these updates.
 - ii. If you would like to send the check ahead of time for registration, we will keep it on file until payments are accepted, then send it to CDFA.
