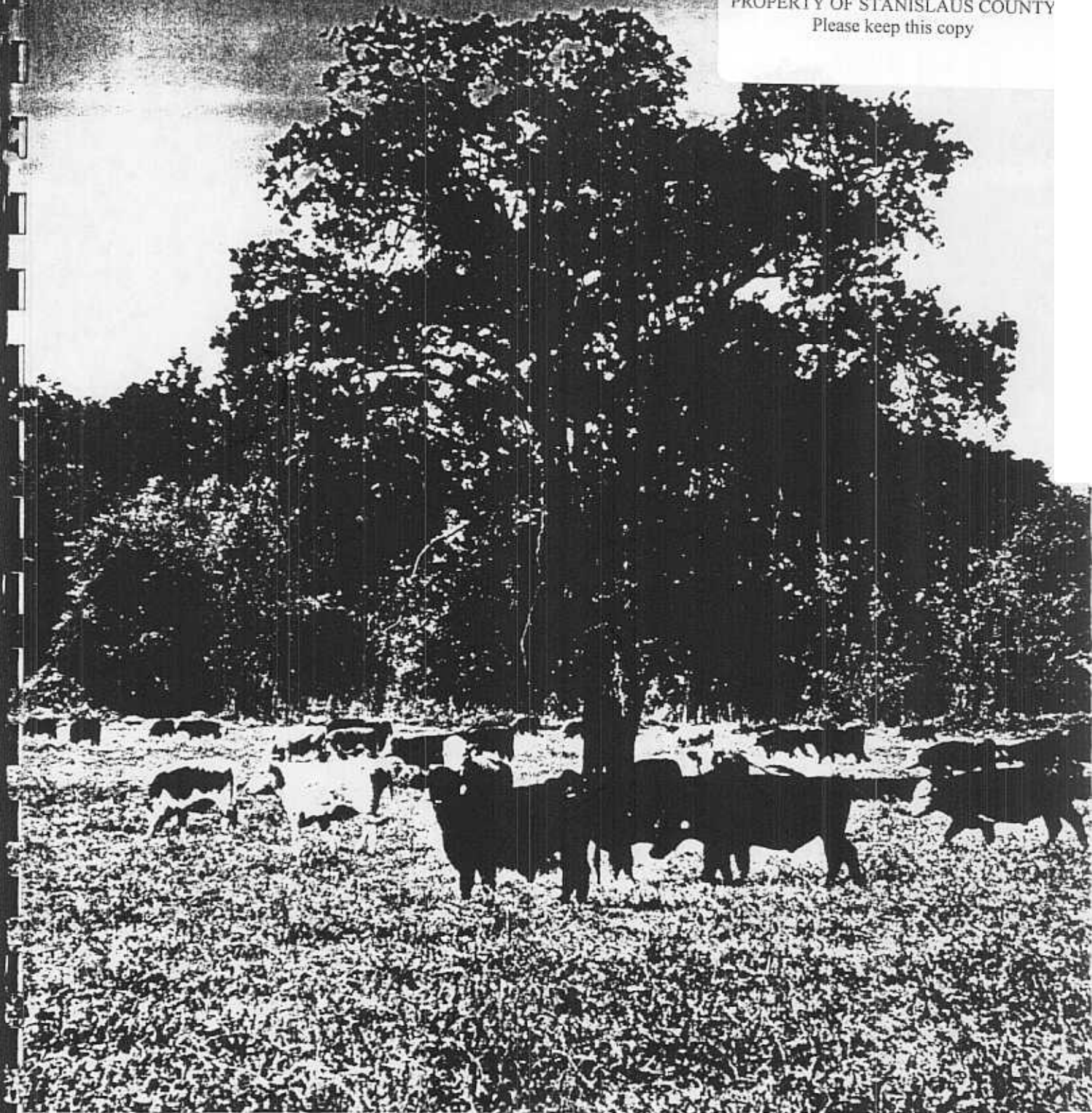

Gentlemen:

The Stanislaus County Agricultural Crop Report for 1982 is hereby submitted in compliance with Section 2279 of the California Food and Agricultural Code.

The gross agricultural income for 1982 is estimated to be \$746,105,400.00. This represents a decrease of 4.5 percent from our 1981 income.

Field crop income was down 13% from the previous year due primarily to a reduction in harvested acres and lower prices for barley and beans.

Lower market price was the principal reason for a significant reduction in income from livestock and poultry.

Although both apricots and walnuts showed substantial gains in income, with excellent crops and good prices, the overall fruit and nut crop income declined by 3.8 million dollars. The unstable market conditions for peaches and grapes and the effects of early fall rain on grape quality, were the factors responsible for the major portion of this decrease.

All estimates in this report represent gross income to the farmer and do not reflect the cost of production.

We wish to express our appreciation to the many persons who contributed to the preparation of this report.
