This notice is an invitation to attend a public meeting to discuss proposed amendments to the Department of Agriculture and Weights and Measures Fee Schedule. The mission of the Agricultural Commissioner is to protect and promote local agricultural and business communities, and we recognize the importance of collaboration with the County's business partners.

The Department is proposing to adjust the following:

- Weighted Labor Rate, the rate at which inspection time is billed, affecting fees for:
 - Phytosanitary Certificate inspections
 - Certified Producer inspections
 - Certified Farmers Market Certificates
 - Standardization inspections
 - Apiary Colony Strength inspections
 - Hemp inspections
 - Non-commercial device inspections
- Farm Labor Contractor Registration Fee

During the meeting, the Department will explain the basis for the proposed changes and provide an opportunity for questions and discussion. This workshop is being conducted prior to consideration and approval of the fee proposal by the Board of Supervisors.
