




## E: Chloropicrin

Stanislaus County has implemented the conditional requirements, outlined in **TABLE 1**, to properly evaluate proposed uses of Chloropicrin in accordance with Volume 3 of the California Department of Pesticide Regulation (CDPR)'s Pesticide Use Enforcement Program Standards Compendium, Appendix K. <b>Notice of Intents (NOI)</b>   <a href="#"><u>Fumigation Resources</u></a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must be submitted to Stanislaus County 96 hours prior to the proposed application date. For fumigations proposed for a Monday, the NOI must be received by Tuesday prior.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must identify the Product Name and EPA Reg. No.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must specify the Fumigation Method</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must include Calculations outlining the Broadcast Equivalency Rate (e.g. Treatment Width, Row Spacing, Percentage of Active Ingredient)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must include <u>ALL</u> applicable signed Vacate/Encroachment Agreements* with neighboring property operators.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must include Maps of the application site identifying the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Distances to all structures/sensitive sites/difficult to evacuate sites</li> <li>○ Treatment Blocks and Acreage</li> <li>○ Permit Number and Site Identification Number</li> <li>○ Outline of area within the field where buffer zone setbacks will be maintained.</li> <li>○ Properties with Vacate/Encroachment Agreements must be referenced.</li> </ul> </li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must include a copy of the Pest Control Recommendation</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Must include a copy of the Fumigation Management Plan</li> </ul>
<b>Field Conditions</b>	The following field conditions must be met at the time of NOI Submission <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Soil moisture and temperature in compliance with Appendix K and/or Label requirements.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Free of debris and in good tilth (Ready for application)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Buffer zone setbacks within the field must be flagged/marked</li> </ul>
<b>Site-specific Permit Conditions</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Applications of Chloropicrin may not proceed until site-specific permit conditions have been issued and approved by the Stanislaus County Agricultural Commissioner's Office.</li> </ul>
